

Food Distribution at Medical Camps

Brown Bag Brigade

- Every Saturday, volunteers distribute 150 brown bag lunches, coffee and oatmeal to the homeless at Santa Ana.
- **More than 50,000 brown bags have been distributed since October 2011.**
- 8 am distribution at Santa Ana shelter.
- Provide non-perishable food as requested by the shelter. Over 5000 bags delivered since 2017

Project Angel

- Identify & provide targeted assistance to help individuals stand up on their feet and break the cycle of homelessness.
- Through this initiative, two individuals, who were previously homeless, are now back on their feet.

Other Programs

- Volunteers collect gently used winter clothing for distribution during November and December at the Santa Ana Civic Center.
- We source personal hygiene items like soap, laundry detergent, toothpaste, toothbrushes, hand towels etc. for monthly distribution to the homeless.

Medical Camps

U-Turn Lives supports local medical camps by providing food to volunteers and patients.

We support the annual medical camps at **Huntington Park** by providing 2 weeks supply of food (pinto beans, rice, corn flour, pasta, pasta sauce, sugar, oatmeal, oil) to each family. **We distribute approximately 8000 lbs. of food at each camp.**

We support the **Anaheim Health Fair** by providing food to 1500 patients, breakfast and lunch to 500 medical professionals and volunteers who donate their time and expertise for the welfare of others.
